HIS HAIR IS CUT AND COMBED in this photograph, cameraman and place unknown, about 1858. A Civil War soldier from Parma, Ohio, was the original owner of this portrait, published in the *Cleveland Plain Dealer* on February 12, 1942, from a print in the Marsch collection. Possibly it is a photographic copy of one of two daguerreotypes, both now lost, taken in Ohio in 1859.
