RARE, UNPUBLISHED PORTRAIT. Although very similar to the preceding pose and made at the same sitting, this handsome photograph is more of a full face. Notice that a larger part of Lincoln's cheek and less of the hair at the back of his head is visible. The difference between these two photographs is much greater than in a stereographic pair (made simultaneously with two adjoining camera lenses). Yet because this portrait so closely resembles the companion pose, it escaped notice until recently when it was discovered by Lloyd Ostendorf in the Lincoln National Life Foundation.
