THE CRAGGY PROFILE OF LINCOLN was often noted by his contemporaries. Wrote Judge Abram Bergen: "No complete idea of the irregularity of the profile of his features can be had from his pictures. . . . In the courtroom, while waiting for the Armstrong case to be called for trial, I . . . studied his face for two full hours. . . . His forehead protruded beyond his eyes more than two inches and retreated rapidly, about 25 degrees from the perpendicular. . . . From the front his eyes looked very deep-set and sunken, by reason of this abnormal extension of the frontal bone."
