A QUERULOUS LOOK FOR GENERAL McCLELLAN. Lincoln sarcastically referred to the Army of the Potomac as "McClellan's bodyguard," and these two enlargements from the Gardner photographs of Lincoln in McClellan's tent show plainly the President's dissatisfaction with the overcautious General whom he was soon to relieve of his command. Enlarged for the first time from the original glass negative in the Library of Congress, the remarkable profile on the left reveals a half-smirk on the President's face as he stares at McClellan.
