PRECISELY HOW THE IMAGES APPEARED on the original plate may be seen from these pictures, assembled for the first time by Lloyd Ostendorf. The lower left pose c of the glass negative was discovered in 1934 in a collection left to Samuel Porter, whose father had operated a gallery in Washington.

There is a slightly different camera angle in each pose, especially obvious at the point where Lincoln's knee and coat seem to touch the table.
