PHOTOGRAPH TAKEN WITH A FOUR-LENS CAMERA by Alexander Gardner, Washington, Sunday, August 9, 1863. The two images on the next page form an irregular half of a four-view plate, evidenced by the variant width of the ellipse formed by the table-top, for the upper lens naturally shows more of the table surface than the lower lens. A small section of missing image c is visible at the extreme left of image d, where the separation of the glass plate is apparent and the table design starts to be repeated.
