THE SPEAKER'S STAND is in the distance. Photograph, probably by an assistant of Mathew B. Brady, Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, November 19, 1863. Improperly labeled in the government archives as "Crowd of Citizens & Soldiers, etc.," this glass negative from the Brady collection was in 1953 tentatively identified as a view of Gettysburg by Josephine Cobb, chief of the Still-Photo Section of the National Archives. She correctly surmised that Lincoln was in the group, at the speaker's stand under the flag.
