

Meserve collection O-88c

"The famous profile" by Anthony Berger, manager of Brady's Gallery, Washington, D. C., made direct from an original collodion negative in the Meserve collection (M–82). One of seven poses taken by Berger on Tuesday, February 9, 1864, it is perhaps the most familiar of Lincoln profiles, a more handsome pose than its companion view (O–89) because Lincoln's profile is less severe and his left eyebrow is more visible. Notice the difference in the sleeve wrinkles in O–88 d and O–89 c.
