A SECOND WHITE HOUSE photograph by Wenderoth & Taylor (of Philadelphia), Washington, D. C., sometime in 1864. In this enlargement of a carte-de-visite portrait, Lincoln has a pensive, almost dreamy expression. The “wrong-side” part in his hair suggests that this picture, like those in the sitting by Berger, was taken in February or March of 1864. Variant (right) shows more of Lincoln’s shoulders.
