1860 CAMPAIGN TINTYPES

Two miniature tintypes (much enlarged) set into circular brass frames and buttons. On the verso of each is a portrait of the vice-presidential candidate, Hannibal Hamlin. The beardless 1860 Brady photograph (left), with face reversed, was extremely popular. The beardless 1858 portrait by Cole (right) was also a favorite with Lincoln supporters.
